



Mayor Adrian O. Mapp & The Plainfield City Council Present Rental Assistance Through American Rescue Plan

The American Rescue Plan is an economic stimulus package to assist with the economic recovery of the U.S.

Through the American Rescue Plan (ARP) funding is currently available for Plainfield households that are behind in their rent and utility services.

Eligible households can qualify for payment of up to 4 months of back rent and other assistance.

Plainfield residents are eligible if they are:

- Behind in their rent since the COVID-19 pandemic began in March 2020 **AND**
- Qualified for unemployment benefits or have lost income.
- Have an increase in expenses due to the COVID-19 pandemic; **AND**
- Have a monthly gross (before tax) household income at or below 80% of the Area Median . **** Please refer to below chart.****
