Twelve (12) New Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield

October 27, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Since our last update on Monday, October 26, there are twelve (12) new COVID-19 cases to report, bringing our total to two thousand, six hundred and twenty-two (2622) confirmed cases since the pandemic began. An additional thirty-six (36) persons have been quarantined. The total amount of persons who have been quarantined since the pandemic began is six thousand, two hundred and fifty-five (6255). **There are no new deaths to report.** The total number of fatalities stands at one hundred and seventeen (117).

Cases in our city are rising. Cold and flu season is among us, so the virus is now more easily hidden with symptoms of other common, less dangerous illnesses. I encourage you to get tested for COVID-19 if you are experiencing cold and flu symptoms that overlap with COVID-19 symptoms. Caution will be what gets us through the autumn and winter season, and ruling out COVID-19 will help to further prevent the spread of the virus. Please also continue to wear your face masks and practice social distancing while in public and while around people that don't live in your home.

In partnership with Union County, the City of Plainfield will provide Plainfield residents with free flu shots. The next date to get your flu shot is, Friday, November 6, from 9:00AM-2:00PM at the Gerald B. Green Building, 200 West 2nd Street.

Stay safe and may God continue to bless each of you.
