Seven (7) New Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield

November 6, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Since our last update on Thursday, November 5, there are seven (7) new COVID-19 cases to report, bringing our total to two thousand, seven-hundred and forty-eight (2748) confirmed cases since the pandemic began. An additional twenty-one (21) persons have been quarantined. The total amount of persons who have been quarantined since the pandemic began is six-thousand, six-hundred and thirty-five (6635). **There are no new deaths to report.** The total number of fatalities stands at one hundred and seventeen (117).

Cases in our city are rising. Cold and flu season is upon us, so the virus is now more easily hidden with symptoms of other common, less dangerous illnesses. I encourage you to get tested for COVID-19 if you are experiencing cold and flu symptoms that overlap with COVID-19 symptoms. Extreme caution will get us safely through the fall and winter season, and isolating COVID-19 will help to prevent the spread of the virus. Please also continue to wear your face masks and practice social distancing while in public and around people that are not a part of your household.

In partnership with Union County, the City of Plainfield will provide residents with free COVID-19 tests and flu shots. COVID-19 tests will be administered **tomorrow, Saturday, November 7 from 1:00PM-4:00PM at the Faith Christian Outreach Center, 533 West 5th Street.** *The COVID-19 test is saliva based; it is advised that you refrain from eating or drinking 30 minutes prior to taking the test.* The next date to get your flu shot is **Friday, November 20 from 9:00AM-2:00PM at the Gerald B. Green Building, 200 West 2nd Street.**

Stay safe and may God continue to bless each of you.
