Seventeen (17) New Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield

October 13, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Since our last update on Thursday, October 8, there are seventeen (17) new COVID-19 cases to report, bringing our total to two thousand, five hundred and twelve (2512) confirmed cases since the pandemic began. Since that date, an additional eighty (80) persons have been quarantined. **There are no new deaths to report today.** The total number of fatalities stands at one hundred and thirteen (113).

I want to remind everyone to continue to wear your face masks and practice social distancing protocols during the upcoming autumn months. Remember to stay home if you are sick, and if you do experience cold or flu symptoms, be sure to get tested for COVID-19.

In partnership with Union County, the City of Plainfield will provide Plainfield residents with free COVID-19 testing and free flu shots. COVID-19 testing will be performed through the saliva-based test. The next date for COVID-19 testing in Plainfield is this **Friday, October 16 from 10:00 AM-12:00 PM at the Jerry Green Building, 200 West 2nd Street**. The next flu shot date in Plainfield is **Friday, October 23 from 9:00AM-2:00PM** at the same location. The more of us that are tested for the virus, the better we will be able to control it.

Stay safe and may God continue to bless each of you.
