Thirty-Seven (37) New Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield

November 4, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Since our last update on Monday, November 2, there are thirty-seven (37) new COVID-19 cases to report, bringing our total to two thousand, seven-hundred and twenty-five (2725) confirmed cases since the pandemic began. Two thousand, four-hundred and thirty-two (2432) persons have recovered. An additional ninety-three (93) persons have been quarantined. The total amount of persons who have been quarantined since the pandemic began is six-thousand, five-hundred and seventy-eight (6578). Five thousand, nine-hundred and twenty-six (5926) people are now out of quarantine. **There are no new deaths to report.** The total number of fatalities stands at one hundred and seventeen (117).
