## From the Mayor's Office

Two Thousand, Two Hundred and Seventy-five (2275) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield.

July 13, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

There is one (1) new confirmed case of COVID-19 in Plainfield and no further deaths. Our total confirmed cases are now two thousand, two-hundred and seventy-five (2275). There have been no fatalities since July 1st. The total amount of deaths stands at one-hundred and ten (110).

On July 8th Governor Phil Murphy signed Executive Order No. 163, which requires individuals to wear face coverings in outdoor public spaces when it is not practicable to socially distance and keep a six-foot distance from others. This order excludes immediate family members, caretakers, household members, or romantic partners, except where doing so would inhibit that individual's health, where the individual is under two years of age, or in situations where individuals cannot feasibly wear a face covering, such as when eating or drinking at outdoor dining areas.

Here in Plainfield, we will continue to exercise an abundance of caution. Our situation does not mirror that of other municipalities. Our success in beating back the virus lies in continued adherence to social distancing and hygienic guidelines. Now is not the time to relax our vigilance.

As we continue to navigate these unchartered waters known as COVID-19, we must each do our part to ensure that we adhere to state and local policies and guidelines. We must continue to flatten the curve so we can return to normal very soon.
