

Two Thousand, Two Hundred and Fifty-Six (2256) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Three Thousand, Six Hundred and Thirty-Five (3635) In Quarantine.

July 2, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Thursday, July 2, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at **Two Thousand, Two Hundred and Fifty-Six (2256)**. There are an additional **Three Thousand, Six Hundred and Thirty-Five (3635)** individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. On Wednesday, July 1, there was one additional death reported due to the virus. The total amount of fatalities now stands at one-hundred and ten (110).
