Two Thousand, One Hundred and Eighty- Four (2184) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Three Thousand, Two-Hundred and Eight (3208) In Quarantine.

June 11, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Thursday, June 11, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at **Two Thousand**, **One Hundred and Eighty-Four (2184)** within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional **Three Thousand**, **Two Hundred and Eight (3208)** individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. There are no new deaths to report today.

Please join us tonight, **Thursday**, **June 11 at 6:00pm**. I will be joined once again by several Faith Leaders for our third fellowship by live broadcast. You can watch it on <u>Plainfield News Channel</u> on YouTube and our <u>Facebook Page</u>. We will be joined by **Reverend Leanora A. Colley of New Covenant Church**, **Bishop Glen A. Colley of New Covenant Church**, **Pastor J. Alfred Johnson of Metropolitan SDA**, **Minister Mustapha Muhammad of the Plainfield Local Organizing Committee**, **Rabbi Howard Tilman of Congregation Beth Israel**, **and Reverend Ted Moore of Grace Episcopal Church**. We hope that these broadcasts provide comfort, bolster faith, and give hope to our community during these challenging times.

Moving forward, we will no longer be sending daily updates. We will send these updates **twice a week on Mondays and Thursdays**. If the numbers begin to rise again, we will increase the frequency as necessary in order for you to be informed and safe.
