To all residents, citizens, neighbors and friends,

I hope that the recent weather has not dampened your spirits nor caused too much inconvenience. Though this recent round of snow has passed, weather forecasts predict below freezing temperatures throughout the weekend. The Division of Public Works in conjunction with Public Safety has been working tirelessly to clear streets of snow and ice, however, caution is urged when traveling.

A Code Blue has been called by Union County Department of Human Services, due to predicted subzero temperatures. If you, your family or neighbors are experiencing heating difficulties or your heat is not working, The City of Plainfield has two warming stations set up for citizens. Shelter is also available at the Plainfield Area YMCA in Plainfield which will also accept walk-ins when possible during a Code Blue. The following locations have been designated as "CODE BLUE" Warming Centers-

1. The Plainfield Senior Citizens Center - 400 East Front Street
2. Washington Community School - 427 Darrow Avenue
3. Plainfield Area YMCA - 518 Watchung Avenue

In an effort to keep all of our residents safe and informed the City is also providing an Emergency Hotline containing pre-recorded instructions and information for your convenience. Call (908) 226-2544. If you need to travel, by car or on foot, please exercise extreme caution. In the event of a medical or other emergency please dial 911 immediately.
