

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the City of Plainfield, Union County, New Jersey Purchasing Division, for the PLAINFIELD POLICE DIVISION EMERGENCY GENERATOR AND UPS INSTALLATION contract, and opened and read in public at the City of Plainfield Municipal Building, 515 Watchung Ave., Plainfield, New Jersey on Wednesday, September 23rd at 11:00 AM prevailing time.

A non-mandatory pre-bid walk through is scheduled on Friday, September 11th, 2015 at 11 AM prevailing time. Bidders are strongly encouraged to attend.

Contract Documents and Plans for the proposed work, prepared by Keith W. Henderson, P.E., of the firm of T&M Associates, Consulting and Municipal Engineers, Eleven Tindall Road, Middletown, New Jersey 07748, are on file in the City of Plainfield Purchasing Division, 515 Watchung Avenue, Plainfield, N.J. 07060 and may be inspected by prospective bidders during business hours. Bidders will be furnished with a copy of the contract documents and plans by the City of Plainfield Purchasing Division, upon proper notice and payment of non-refundable copy cost of \$10.00.

Proposals must be made on the Standard Proposal Forms in a manner designated in the contract documents, must be enclosed in a **sealed envelope** bearing the name and address of the bidder and the name of the work on the outside, addressed to the CindyLea Weber, Purchasing Agent, City of Plainfield, Division of Purchasing, 515 Watchung Ave, Plainfield, N.J. 07060 and must be accompanied by all items identified in the Contract Documents including, but not limited to, a Statement of Consent of Surety from a surety company holding a Certificate of Authorization to do business in the State of New Jersey and a bid guarantee (Proposal Security) for not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid except that the guarantee need not exceed \$20,000.00.

Prospective bidders are hereby notified that an **original and one (1) copy of the entire bid package along with (1) CD** must be submitted to the City.

The City of Plainfield reserves the right to consider the bids for sixty (60) days after the receipt thereof, and further reserves the right to reject any or all bids, either in whole or in part and also to waive any informality in any and make such awards or take action as may be in the best interest of the City of Plainfield.
