The above contract shall be performed in strict accordance with the contract documents, including any technical specifications which are on file with the City Purchasing Agent. Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries as wages as set forth in the contract documents must be paid on this project and that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

Proposers are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A.10:5-31 et. seq. and N.J.A.C.17:27 as well as the affirmative action requirements of the City of Plainfield. Such requirements are included in the proposal documents.

The City of Plainfield reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive any defects or informalities in proposals as it shall deem in the best interest of the City of Plainfield, New Jersey.

Proposals may be held by the City for a period not to exceed sixty (60) calendar days from the date of opening the proposals for the purpose of reviewing the proposals and investigating the qualifications of the vendors prior to awarding the contract.
