Pot Hole Repairs 2.8.11

Road Safety

Plainfield, NJ February 8, 2011: On behalf of the Office of the Mayor, the Honorable Sharon Robinson-Briggs informs the public on the City's response to the number of pot holes in the city's roadways. Recent winter storms have covered the roadways with snow and ice. As the ice melts and temperatures drop, cracks in the road surface begin to open, causing pot holes. Many of the pot holes in the city streets are to be found in older roadways, making driving uncomfortable for many motorists. As weather conditions abated last week, the DPW Road Repair Unit began filling pot holes along the city's main thoroughfares. Mayor Robinson-Briggs, reminds commuters and residents that pot hole repairs will continue throughout the winter season, as weather permits. Motorists are advised to drive with care, reducing speed over challenging road surfaces. Residents are encouraged to call-in dangerous pot holes, with the understanding that weather, time and conditions in the roadway will impact the response time of our Road Repair Unit.
