BASEBALL RULES – MILT CAMPBELL FIELD

PLAINFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE

Sec. 2:8-16. Division of Recreation

A certificate of insurance for all appropriate liability, bodily injury and property damage insurance coverage in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 must be submitted prior to permit approval.

2:8-16(a.b.c) The organization must have at least the minimum number of players to make a team (9) to secure a permit for a field. Written confirmation that requirement has been met is due in the Recreation Office by the start of the game season.

2:8-16(a.c) Changing clothes/uniforms outside on the field is not permitted. Restrooms must be used for this purpose.

2:8-16(a.d-6) There will be no food or vending inside or outside of the premises, unless approved by the Superintendent of Recreation and the proper permits are obtained.

2:8-16(a.c) A storage location is provided for Plainfield organizations that submit a request and receive an approval from the Plainfield Parks and Recreation Superintendent. Organizations requesting storage must add the facility on the required insurance coverage.

2:8-16(a.c) Keys will be provided for the bathrooms. It is prohibited that additional copies are made without the authorization of the Plainfield Parks and Recreation Superintendent. Keys are to be returned no later than one week after the organization's permit listing.

2:8-16(d-13) No person/organization without authorization shall distribute any circulars, cards, or written matter or post, or paste, or affix any placard, notice or sign within any playground or park. Organizations will have the option to utilize available fencing and/or permanent structures for posting signs and banners.

2:8-16(a.b.c) A maximum of (61) cars are allowed to park in the parking lot on Third Street side of Milt Campbell Field.

2:8-16(a.b.c) All Adult Leagues authorized to use Milt Campbell Field will be charged for either a full or half of pallet of field marking material. A vendor that can provide documented reference in this field of expertise. The chosen vendor must be able to provide a full or half pallet of field marking lime material. Documented proof of payment prior to the issuance of your permit. Note: Permit holder will be responsible for field marking compliance.

2:8-16(a.b.c) There will be no parking on the field or grass unless authorized by the Superintendent of Recreation.

2:8-16(a.d-1) There shall be no repairs of any sort done to the facility, unless authorized by the Superintendent of Recreation.

2:8-16(a.b.c) Street parking is permitted only in areas where signs are posted. **Parking in Residents driveways and blocking is strictly prohibited.**

2:8-16(a.b.c) In the event of severe weather conditions such as: heavy rain and or thunder & lightning games will be cancelled. If the weather conditions change then the determination to resume games will be based on the condition of the baseball fields. You may contact the Superintendent @ (908) 451-1412 for information.

2:8-16(a.b.c) An employee of the Division of Recreation (Playground Monitor) will conduct a pre-inspection to verify the conditions of the field before and after each use.

Violations of the baseball field usage rules and/or Plainfield Municipal Code for Parks & Playgrounds will result in the suspension and possible denial of your permit request for the remainder of the season.
