

# **PLAINFIELD DIVISION OF RECREATION**

## **FOOTBALL RULES - SEIDLER FIELD**

### **PLAINFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE**

#### **Sec. 2:8-16. Division of Recreation**

A certificate of insurance for all appropriate liability, bodily injury and property damage insurance coverage in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 must be submitted prior to permit approval.

**2:8-16(a.b.c)** Any changes in permit requests such as extra games scheduled must be approved by the Superintendent of Recreation.

**2:8-16(a.c)** There will be no food vending inside or outside of the premises unless approved by the Superintendent of Recreation and the proper permits are obtained.

**2:8-16(a.b.c)** Only authorized person permitted in announcers booth: President, Vice-President, Athletic Director and (1) Coach per team. Names must be given to the Recreation Office before any authorized person above enters the booth. Please keep in mind all equipment inside the announcers booth is property of the City of Plainfield & New Jersey Wolves Semi-pro Football Organization therefore any broken, lost or stolen equipment, will be the responsibility of the organization and you can face possible termination of your permit.

**2:8-16(a.c)** It is prohibited that additional copies are made without the authorization of the Plainfield Parks and Recreation Superintendant. Keys are to be returned no later the one week after the organization's permit listing.

**2:8-16(a.b.c)** Clean up of the football field, bleachers, bathrooms and perimeter of facility i.e. (discarding bottles, cans, papers and other debris) will be the responsibility of the permit holder. Trash should be secured by placing it in trash cans or in tied plastic bags. Inspection of facility condition will be done before and after each game by Recreation staff (Playground monitor). Permit holder must obtain Health Permit prior to operating concession stand. Peddler's permit along with the Health permit is required to operate concession stand.

**2:8-16(a.b.c)** Storage for equipment is provided for Plainfield youth organizations that submit a request and receive an approval from the Plainfield Parks and Recreation Superintendant. The storage location will be located at the Joe Black Baseball Field and a key will be issued to the president of the organization.

**2:8-16(a.b.c)** Organizations requesting storage must add the facility on the required insurance coverage. No person/organization without authorization shall distribute any circulars, cards, or written matter or post, or paste, or affix any placard, notice or sign within any playground or park. Organizations will have the option to utilize available fencing and/or permanent structures for posting signs and banners.

**2:8-16(a.c)** It is prohibited that additional copies are made without the authorization of the Plainfield Parks and Recreation Superintendant. Keys are to be returned no later the one week after the organization's permit listing.

**2:8-16(a.b.c)** All Adult Leagues authorized to use Seidler's Field will be charged for either a full or half of pallet of field marking material. A vendor that can provide documented reference in this field of expertise. The chosen vender must be able to provide a full or half pallet of field marking lime material. Documented proof of payment prior to the issuance of your permit. Note: Permit holder will be responsible for field marking compliance.

**2:8-16(a.c)** The concession stand must be cleaned up by the organization at the end of their game and/ or activities; i.e. fryer, grills, floor etc. Grease from fryer must be discarded by the permit holder

There shall be no repairs of any sort done to the facility, unless authorized by the Superintendent of Recreation

**2:8-16(a.b.c)** In the event of severe weather conditions such as: heavy rain and or thunder & lighting games will be cancelled. If the weather conditions change then the determination to resume games will be based on the condition of the football field. The Playground Monitor will make an observation of the football field to determine if it is in playable condition. You may contact the Superintendent @ (908) 451-1412 for information.

**2:8-16(a.b.c)** In the event of light rain, contact the Superintendent @ 908-451-1412 to verify if the football field is in playable condition.

**2:8-16(a.c)** Entrance gate on Garfield Avenue will remain open as long as there are no unauthorized vehicles entering or blocking the driveway, failure to adhere to the request will result in gate being closed but not locked. Only authorized vehicles permitted beyond gate will be delivering items to concession stand, must leave immediately after unloading

**2:8-16(a. c)** Banner placement is only permitted on the 6ft. fence which is located across from the concession stand and handicap accessible bathroom.

**2:8-16(a.b.c)** Street parking is permitted only in areas where signs are posted. Parking in residents' driveways and blocking driveways is strictly prohibited.

**2:8-16(a.b.c)** Failure to adhere to the rules and regulations set-forth by the Division of Parks & Recreation for obtaining a permit for the usage of Seidler's Field can result in the suspension of your permit

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***Violations of the football field usage rules and/or Plainfield Municipal Code for Parks & Playgrounds will result in the suspension and possible denial of your permit request for the remainder of the season.***
