This application does not guarantee acceptance into the Parade. All applications will be reviewed for appropriateness and fit with the parade theme. All applicants will be notified of their acceptance or denial from this parade 2 weeks prior to the Parade. Application fees will be returned for all groups not accepted into the parade.

PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The parade committee reserves the right to refuse any entry into the parade that does not depict the theme and patriotic purpose or does not adhere to the parade rules and regulation.
2. All applications received after the deadline are subject to availability and committee approval.
3. All participants must stay in their assigned order, unless specifically directed otherwise by a parade official.
4. Drivers of motor vehicles must hold a valid Driver's License and show evidence of insurance.
5. Vehicles must follow a straight course in a cautious and safe manner. There shall be no quick starts, stops or peeling rubber. No swerving back and forth and no reckless driving of any kind.
6. No person shall ride on hood, roof, trunk or doorframes of vehicles, unless authorized by City of Plainfield.
7. Handholds must be provided for all float riders.
8. There shall be no throwing of any type of item from vehicles to spectators.
9. Only designated parade sponsors will be permitted to distribute handouts and giveaways.
10. The parade is a non-political event. Only current office holders will be allowed to enter the parade. Use of political signs of participants advocating political or social positions or issues will not be permitted.
11. Participants that offend the sensibilities of others or are indecent are not permitted.
12. No fireworks, firearms, or open flames are allowed by any parade participants.
13. No jumping on or off vehicles.
14. Any performance along the route must be a moving/marching routine. Any unit that stops to perform other than in front of the judging stand will be ineligible for an award.
15. All performances in front of the judge's stand cannot be more than 2 minutes or they will be ineligible for an award.
16. Any unit where music is played must set the volume at a level so they do not intrude on the other participant's presentation space. Any parade official may request the volume to be lowered if they deem it too loud.
17. All participants should leave appropriate space between themselves and the next unit (2 car lengths), neither should spacing be too large (over 3 car lengths).
18. Parade participants must proceed past the end of the parade route before stopping and unloading.
19. Anyone with alcohol at the parade staging area or along the parade route will have his or her entire unit removed from the lineup immediately.
20. Any unit whose participants argue with, use foul language or refuse to do what a parade official asks will be removed from the lineup immediately.
21. Traffic citations may be issued by the Plainfield Police Department for violation of any municipal ordinance or State vehicle code.
22. All participants will be inspected in the lineup area for compliance with all rules prior to the beginning of the parade. Failure to comply will result in removal from the line up.

HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION:

Parade Applicants and all participants agree that neither the City of Plainfield nor any public or private property owners whose property is utilized for the Parade, shall be liable for injury or damage to the property of the Applicant, it's employees, invitees, customers or any other person in or around the Applicant's parade unit, regardless of the cause or source of the injury or damage. The Applicant further agrees that neither the City of Plainfield nor any other public or private owner, whose property is utilized for the event, shall be liable for any damages arising directly or indirectly from any act or omission of event sponsors or any customer at the event and does hereby agree to waive any and all claims or causes of action for damages, losses or expenses against the City of Plainfield, its agents, public officials, officers, employees and authorized volunteers.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Applicant shall indemnify, keep and save harmless the City of Plainfield, New Jersey and its agents, officers, and employees and any other public or private property owner whose property is utilized for the event, against all injuries, death, losses damages, claims, suits, liabilities, judgments, cost and expenses, which arise directly for any negligence or reckless or willful misconduct of the Applicant, its participants, employees or agents. The Applicant shall pay, all its own expenses, appear, defend and pay all charges of attorney and all cost and other expenses arising there from or incurred in connection therewith. If any judgment shall be rendered against the City of Plainfield or another property owner in such action, the Applicant shall, at its own expense, satisfy and discharge the same
