Prospective respondents are hereby notified that five original black and white copies of the entire proposal package must be submitted to the City.

The City of Plainfield reserves the right to consider the RFPs for sixty (60) days after the receipt thereof, and further reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, either in whole or in part and also to waive any informality in any and make such awards or take action as may be in the best interest of the City of Plainfield..

RFPs must be prepared and submitted in the manner designated therein and required by the RFP, must be enclosed in sealed envelopes bearing the name and address of the respondent firm on the outside and also bearing on the outside reference to the particular request in response. Said RFPs shall be addressed and delivered to the Office of the City Clerk, City of Plainfield, 515 Watchung Avenue, Plainfield, New Jersey 07060 before said bids are read aloud on the date and time prescribed.

The award of the contract shall be made subject to the necessary moneys to do the work being provided by the City of Plainfield in a lawful manner. The contract to be executed by the successful bidder will provide that it shall not become effective until the necessary moneys to do the work have been provided by the City of Plainfield in a lawful manner. The award shall further be subjected to the securing of necessary State, Federal or Local permits governing the work.

Respondents are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et. seq., N.J.A.C. 17:27 (Affirmative Action), P.L. 1963. C150 (New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act), and Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12101, et.seq.).

The contractor is further notified that s/he must comply with P.L. 1977, c. 33, and submit a Disclosure Statement listing stockholders with his bid.

The respondent is further notified that s/he must comply with P.L. 1999 c.238 Public Works Contractor Registration Act and he and any subcontractors must be registered in accordance with the act.

The contractor is also further notified that's/ he must comply with P.L. 2004 c. 57 and submit proof of business registration and submit proof of business registration for any named subcontractors in accordance with the act.
