Position: **PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATOR**

Department: Public Affairs & Safety

Division: Police

Salary Range: \$41,248-54,984 Full time – 35 hours per week

- **Experience Requirements:** One (1) year of experience in work involving the receiving, transmitting, and relaying of video display and/or radio messages, and in the receiving, relaying and recording of complaints and requests for emergency assistance, which shall have included the use of video display, data processing, automatic number identification, automatic location identification, switching equipment, or other computer oriented equipment.
- **NOTE:** Public Safety Answering Points (PSAP) means the first point of reception of a 9-1-1 call. Public Safety Dispatch Points (PSDP) means a location which provides dispatch services for one or more public safety agencies. Appointees to positions at Public Safety Answering Points and at some Public Safety Dispatch Points must have achieved training and certification by the Office of Emergency Telecommunications Services (OETS) in the Department of Law and Public Safety as required by NJAC 17:24-2.2.
- **LICENSE:** Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
