On January 8, 2001, Councilwoman Elizabeth A. Urquhart was elected City Council President for 2001.

On January 8, 2001, Albert C. Hendricks was elected by the City Council as Councilman-at-Large, First and Fourth Wards, for a term until the next General Election (November 6, 2001), due to the RESIGNATION of Councilman Joseph Scott, Sr.

On January 8, 2001, Councilman Joseph Montgomery was elected City Council Chairperson, Committee of the Whole, for 2001.

On January 16, 2001, the City Council adopted a resolution (R 102-01) memorializing and ratifying the appointment of Albert C. Hendricks to the City Council as Councilman-at-Large, First and Fourth Wards, to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Joseph Scott, Sr., as Councilman-at-Large, First and Fourth Wards, until the next General Election (November 6, 2001).

At the November 6, 2001, General Election, the following were elected:

Albert T. McWilliams, Mayor, four-year term, beginning January 1, 2002.

Albert C. Hendricks, Councilman-at-Large, First and Fourth Wards, four-year term, beginning November 6, 2001 and ending January 1, 2006.

Joanne Hollis, Councilwoman, Fourth Ward, four-year term, beginning January 1, 2002.
