On January 8, 2002, Councilwoman Elizabeth A. Urquhart was elected City Council President for 2002.

On January 8, 2002, Councilman Joseph Montgomery was elected City Council Chairperson, Committee of the Whole, for 2002.

On January 8, 2002, the City Council defeated a resolution (R 035-02) that would appoint Thomas J. Morrison, III, as City Administrator for a term concurrent with the Mayor.

On January 8, 2002, a communication from the Mayor appointed Thomas J. Morrison, III, as ACTING City Administrator.

On May 7, 2002, a communication from the Mayor reappointed Thomas J. Morrison, III, as ACTING City Administrator as of May 9, 2002.

On September 4, 2002, the City Council defeated a resolution (R 482-02) that would appoint Thomas J. Morrison, III, as City Administrator for a term concurrent with the Mayor.

On October 1, 2002, a communication from the Mayor appointed John J. Coughlin to serve as Interim City Administrator as of October 1, 2002.
