On January 7, 2003, Councilman Malcolm R. Dunn was elected City Council President Pro-Temporare for the Re-Organizational Meeting.

On January 7, 2003, Councilman Malcolm R. Dunn was elected City Council Chairperson, Committee of the Whole, for 2003.

On January 7, 2003, John J. Coughlin was appointed Interim City Administrator by contract for Management Consultant Services.

On January 21, 2003, Councilman Joseph H. Montgomery was elected President Pro-Temporare for the Regular Meeting.

On January 17, 2003, a communication from the Mayor appointed Robert F. Casey as Interim City Administrator effective January 21, 2003.

On January 21, 2003, the City Council adopted a resolution (R 044-03) authorizing a contract Jersey Professional Management and Consulting Services to be provided by Robert F. Casey as Interim City Administrator effective January 21, 2003.

On February 3, 2003, Councilman Joseph H. Montgomery was elected City Council President for 2003.

On April 7, 2003, Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr. was appointed City Administrator for term April 7, 2003 to January 1, 2006 (term concurrent with Mayor).

On April 21, 2003, the City Council adopted a resolution (E 215-03) authorizing a contract with Jersey Professional Management for Consulting Services to be provided by Robert F. Casey as Acting Director of Administration and Finance for 90 days as of April 21, 2004.

On August 4, 2003, Ronald E. West was appointed Director of Administration and Finance for term August 4, 2003 to January 1, 2006 (term concurrent with Mayor).

At the November 4, 2003 General Election, the following were elected:
