Plainfield, NJ – February 2, 2016 – Mayor of Plainfield, Adrian O. Mapp will deliver the State of The City Address this Thursday.

After being delayed by clean up efforts from historic blizzard Jonas, Mayor of Plainfield, Adrian Mapp is set to deliver the State of the City Address this Thursday.

The Address will highlight the administration’s major accomplishments during 2015 while outlining strategic plans for 2016.

It will include reports from the Department of Public Affairs and Safety, Finance, Public Works, Community Relations and Economic Development as well as others.

Mayor Mapp is no stranger to public service having served the residents of Plainfield on the City Council since 1998 and as a Union County Freeholder from 2005 – 2007. Elected by popular vote in 2013, he assumed the role of Mayor of Plainfield in January of 2014. He has been a Plainfield resident for over 36 years and has married and raised a family here.
