Dear Friends and Neighbors,

I regret to inform you that earlier this afternoon, Plainfield recorded its second positive case of COVID-19. Please remain calm and continue the recommended distancing and hygienic practices. The risk of contracting the virus remains low at this time.

Our Division of Health and the City Administration is working very closely with the patients and their families to manage the case as per NJDOH guidelines.

We are requesting that all residents wash their hands frequently, cover your cough with a bent elbow, practice social distance guidelines, avoid those who are sick, stay home if you are sick and contact your health care provider.

Residents can call the hotline number: 1-800-222-1222 or 1-800-962-1253 if using an out-of-state line. Trained healthcare professionals are standing by to answer your call 24/7.

The NJ Department of Human Services operates a toll free "warm line" which is a resource for people seeking mental health service. The warm line is activated during events that impact the mental health of New Jersey residents. The warm line is available 24 hours and has language access; (877) 294-HELP (4357).
