One Hundred and Fifty-Nine (159) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield – Many Jobs Available in NJ
April 3, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Friday April 3, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at one hundred and fifty-nine (159). There are an additional one hundred and seventy-two (172) individuals quarantined as a result of exposure, and an 86 year old female succumbed to the virus.

Below are the latest figures for New Jersey and Union County:

NEW CASES = New Jersey 4,372	TOTAL 29,895
NEW CASES = Union County 251	TOTAL 2,487

DEATHS = New Jersey 113	TOTAL 646
DEATHS = Union County 11	TOTAL 45

If you think you've been exposed to the virus – the closest testing site is at Kean University. The numbers to call are: (908) 373-5105 and (908) 214-7107.

Walk-ups are not allowed at the test site; all individuals being tested must be in their cars with the windows rolled up, until the moment of testing. This has been mandated so as to minimize the risk of exposing others to the virus.
