Two Hundred and Ninety-Six (296) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Thirty Three (33) People Recovered

April 7, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Tuesday April 7, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at two hundred and ninety-six (296). There are an additional three hundred and seven (307) individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. With a heavy heart I share that we lost four more to the ravages of the virus, two males forty-three (43) and fifty-eight (58) respectively and, two females fifty-six (56) and eighty-six (86). Thirty-three (33) persons have been effectively quarantined and have recovered from the virus.

My heart aches for our Plainfield families, and families across our nation, who are dealing with loss during this unprecedented time of difficulty. The key to ending this pandemic lies in our hands – we just need the will-power and discipline to implement full voluntary quarantine on ourselves and our households.

I cannot implore you with any greater passion than I am right now. Please stay off the streets, reconsider what you deem essential, pay strict attention to personal hygiene, and wear a mask if you must go out. There isn't anything that is more important than life.
