Four Hundred and Thirty-Three (433) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Five Hundred and Forty-Five (545) Individuals Quarantined

April 10, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Friday April 10, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at Four Hundred and Thirty-Three (433). There are an additional Five Hundred and Forty-Five (545) individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. Thankfully, no new deaths were reported today.

To further encourage all Plainfield families to stay indoors and practice social distancing, all parks and athletic fields, including Hub Stine field, are closed until further notice. In addition, the White House Coronavirus Task Force leaders urge all Americans to avoid visiting grocery stores unless it is absolutely necessary. The next two weeks are vital in slowing the spread of the virus, so if you must go to the supermarket, be sure to go alone and follow the 6-8 feet distancing protocol.
