## From the Mayor's Office

**One Thousand, Three Hundred and Four (1304) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional One Thousand, Seven Hundred and Eighty-Six (1786) Under Quarantine.**

April 25, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Saturday, April 25, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at **One Thousand, Three Hundred and Four (1304)** within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional **One Thousand, Seven Hundred and Eighty-Six (1786)** individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. There are no new fatalities to report.

I am pleased to share that testing for COVID-19 is now a reality in Plainfield. If you're experiencing symptoms you think might be related to the coronavirus please call our hotline at **(908) 546-1084 Monday-Friday from 8:30AM-5:00PM**. You'll be connected to a health professional who will conduct a medical telehealth screening. If you meet the criteria for testing, arrangements will be made for you to be tested at the drive through site at Kean University, or by a mobile unit which will come to your residence. After 5:00PM and on weekends, please call the Union County hotline at (908) 214-7107
