## From the Mayor's Office

### **One Thousand, Three Hundred and Seventy-Nine (1379) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Four (1904) Under Quarantine.**

April 27, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Monday, April 27, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at One Thousand, Three Hundred and Seventy-Nine (1379) within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Four (1904) individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. It's with a very heavy heart I share that we have six (6) additional fatalities to report. Two African American males both 73 years old, and four females; three African American ages eighty-three (83), eighty-six (86) and eighty-five (85), and one white age eighty-seven (87). Our hearts are with those who have lost a loved one or have loved ones fighting the virus during this very, very difficult time.

COVID-19 testing is now a reality in Plainfield. If you're experiencing symptoms you think might be related to the coronavirus please call our hotline at **(908) 546-1084 Monday-Friday from 8:30AM-5:00PM**. You'll be connected to a health professional who will conduct a medical telehealth screening. If you meet the criteria for testing, arrangements will be made for you to be tested at the drive through site at Kean University, or by a mobile unit which will come to you. After 5:00PM and on weekends, please call the Union County hotline at (908) 214-7107
