One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Twenty-One (1921) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Two Thousand, Six Hundred and Seven (2607) Quarantined.

May 11, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Monday, May 11, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at one thousand, nine hundred and twenty-one (1921) within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional two thousand, six hundred and seven (2607) individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. Sadly, There are two additional fatalities today, a seventy-four (74), and fifty-eight (58) year old, both are hispanic males.
