One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Eighty-Eight (1988) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Two Thousand, Six Hundred and Sixty-Five (2665) In Quarantine.

May 14, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Thursday, May 14, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at **one thousand, nine hundred and eighty-eight (1988)** within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional **two thousand, six hundred and sixty-five (2665)** individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. Unfortunately, there are three new deaths to report today due to the virus, a 73-year-old female, and two unknown individuals, a female and male, of ages 59 and 60 respectively. This brings the total amount of fatalities to 62.

Governor Phil Murphy has signed an executive order which allows non-essential construction programs to resume and permits curbside pickup at non-essential retail businesses. This order will go into effect on Monday, May 18, 2020. Those who will participate in non-essential construction and curbside pickup must abide by the requirements in the order which are listed [here](#). In addition, car gatherings for the purpose of drive-through and drive-in events are also permitted. I urge all Plainfield residents to continue to follow social distancing and hygiene practices as the state attempts to return to a sense of normalcy.

Join me **tonight, May 14th at 6:00PM** for a special broadcast which will be streamed live on the City of Plainfield's Facebook page [HERE](#) and on our Youtube Channel [HERE](#). I've invited several of the city's spiritual leaders to offer words of encouragement directly to the Plainfield community. In these challenging times, it is vital that we remain united and strong. It is our hope that words of comfort and upliftment from our faith leaders will offer solace and hope, to bolster our spirits.
