Two Thousand and Forty-Seven (2047) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Two Thousand, Seven Hundred and Twelve (2712) In Quarantine.

May 19, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Tuesday, May 19, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at **two thousand and forty-seven (2047)** within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional **two thousand, seven hundred and twelve (2712)** individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. Unfortunately, there is one new death to report today due to the virus, an 88-year-old Hispanic female, bringing the total amount of fatalities to seventy-three (73).

As part of our COVID-19 relief efforts, the City of Plainfield is distributing free lunches to Plainfield residents. Lunch is distributed every day, Monday through Friday, from 11:00AM- 1:00PM. Distribution started at the Gerald B. Green Plaza this past Monday, and will begin at the Rushmore Playground next week, Tuesday, May 26. Proof of residency is required.

The Plainfield COVID-19 Relief Fund is still accepting checks and tangible donations. If you would like to make a monetary donation, please send your check or money order to: **Plainfield COVID-19 Relief Fund, Plainfield City Hall, Office of the Mayor, 515 Watchung Ave., Plainfield, NJ, 07060.** You can also bring tangible donations to any of the City's three fire stations. **If you are in need and would like to apply for aid please go to the COVID-19 page on the city website [HERE](#) and complete the application.** Proof of residency and hardship is required.

I thank every resident who has lent a hand during this crisis.
