Two Thousand and Fifty-Nine (2059) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Two Thousand, Seven Hundred and Twenty-Two (2722) In Quarantine.

May 20, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Wednesday, May 20, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at **two thousand and fifty-nine (2059)** within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional **two thousand, seven hundred and twenty-two (2722)** individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. There are five new deaths to report today due to the virus, a thirty-seven (37) year old Caucasian female, a forty (40) year old Caucasian man, an eighty-eight (88) year old African-American female, and two unknown individuals, a male and female, of ages eighty-two (82) and ninety-one (91), respectively. This brings the total amount of fatalities to seventy-eight (78).

Governor Phil Murphy has partnered with Walmart and Quest Diagnostics to expand testing capacity in New Jersey. Seven Walmart stores across the state will be opened to drive-through testing in their parking lots beginning on Friday, May 22, 2020. The Walmart locations are as follows: **Garfield, North Bergen, Kearny, Flemington, Burlington, Howell, and Mount Laurel**. As part of our COVID-19 relief efforts, the City of Plainfield is distributing free lunches to Plainfield residents. Lunch is distributed every day, Monday through Friday, from 11:00AM- 1:00PM. Distribution started at the Gerald B. Green Plaza this past Monday, and will begin at the Rushmore Playground next week, Tuesday, May 26.
