Two Thousand and Sixty-Seven (2067) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Two Thousand, Seven Hundred and Fifty-Six (2756) In Quarantine.

May 21, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Thursday, May 21, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at **two thousand and sixty-seven (2067)** within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional **two thousand, seven hundred and fifty-six (2756)** individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. There are six new deaths to report today due to the virus, three African-American women of ages seventy-eight (78), eighty-one (81), and ninety-four (94), and three unknown individuals, two males and one female of ages eighty (80), eighty-five (85), and ninety-two (92), respectively. This brings the total amount of fatalities to eighty-four (84).

New Jersey residents enrolled in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) will be able to use their benefits to order groceries online beginning next week. Online grocery shopping will be available through Amazon and participating Walmarts, ShopRites, and The Fresh Grocers. For more information, [click here](#). I encourage Plainfield residents who receive SNAP benefits to shop online in order to help lessen the spread of the virus.

Governor Phil Murphy has partnered with Walmart and Quest Diagnostics to expand testing capacity in New Jersey. Seven Walmart stores across the state will be opened to drive-through testing in their parking lots beginning **tomorrow Friday, May 22, 2020**. The Walmart locations are as follows: **Garfield, North Bergen, Kearny, Flemington, Burlington, Howell, and Mount Laurel**. As part of our COVID-19 relief efforts, the City of Plainfield is distributing free lunches to Plainfield residents. Lunch is distributed every day, Monday through Friday, from 11:00AM- 1:00PM. Distribution started at the Gerald B. Green Plaza this past Monday.
