Two Thousand and Eighty-Six (2086) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Two Thousand, Eight Hundred and Sixty-Two (2862) In Quarantine.

May 26, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Tuesday, May 26, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at **Two Thousand and Eighty-Six (2086)** within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional **Two Thousand, Eight Hundred and Sixty-Two (2862)** individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. There are two new fatalities to report today, a ninety (90) year old Caucasian male, and a ninety-two (92) year old unknown female. This brings the total amount of fatalities to ninety-seven (97).

Please join us tomorrow, **Wednesday, May 27, at 6:00PM** for a special Live Broadcast. During this broadcast, I will lay out my plan for the re-opening of City Hall. It will be Live on [Plainfield News Channel](#) on YouTube and our [Facebook Page](#).

On Thursday, May 28th at 6:00pm I'll be joined once again by several of our Community Faith Leaders for our second live broadcast. We'll be joined by **Pastor Clinton Parker III of Calvary Baptist Church, Reverend Dean of Visions of God Family Worship, Pastor Wilbur Robinson of Faith Christian Outreach Center, and Reverend Reginald McRae of Mt. Zion AME Church of Plainfield**, among other Faith leaders. It is our hope that these broadcasts provide comfort, bolster faith and give hope to our community during these challenging times.

As part of our COVID-19 relief efforts, the City of Plainfield is distributing free lunches to Plainfield residents. Lunch is distributed every day, Monday through Friday, from 11:00AM- 1:00PM at **the Gerald B. Green Plaza** and at the **corner of Grant Avenue and West 3rd Street**.
