## From the Mayor's Office

**Two Thousand, One Hundred and Thirty-six (2136) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Total Amount of Fatalities is One Hundred (100).**

May 31, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Sunday, May 31, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at two thousand, one hundred and thirty-six (2136) within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional two thousand, nine hundred and forty-one (2941) individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. There are no new deaths to report today. The total amount of fatalities is one hundred (100).

My Administration and the City Council have announced a NO tax increase for residents in 2020. The City made reductions in over one hundred (100) budget lines that impact each division. This has resulted in a reduction of \$2,262,000, representing 2.6% of the total budget. The purpose of these major budget cuts is to provide relief to Plainfield residents during these very difficult times.

The Plainfield City Council will meet on **June 8, 2020 at 7PM** to vote on the possible adoption of the 2020 budget. Please join this virtual Zoom meeting here: <https://zoom.us/j/99101955881>
