One Thousand, Seven Hundred and Eighty (1780) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Two Thousand, Four Hundred and One (2401) In Quarantine.

May 5, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Tuesday, May 5, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at **one thousand, seven hundred and eighty (1780)** within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional **two thousand, four hundred and one (2401)** individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. Sadly, I must report three additional fatalities as a result of the virus, a 64-year-old Hispanic female, and two unknown males of ages 61 and 84. This brings the total number of fatalities to 51.

During the length of this pandemic, many of you have asked me what can be done to help. Many of us want to lend a helping hand to those struggling through this crisis. As of today, recent graduates of nursing, pharmacy, physician assistant, and respiratory care therapy programs **can apply for temporary emergency licenses**, even if they haven't yet been able to take or pass their licensing exams.
