One Thousand, Eight Hundred and Twenty-one (1821) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Two Thousand, Four Hundred and Thirty (2430) In Quarantine.

May 6, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Wednesday, May 6, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at **one thousand, eight hundred and twenty-one (1821)** within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional **two thousand, four hundred and thirty (2430)** individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. Fortunately, there are no additional fatalities to report today.

COVID-19 testing is now a reality in Plainfield. If you're experiencing symptoms you think might be related to the coronavirus please call our hotline at **(908) 546-1084 Monday-Friday from 8:30AM-5:00PM**. You'll be connected to a health professional who will conduct a medical telehealth screening. If you meet the criteria for testing, arrangements will be made for you to be tested at the drive through site at Kean University, or by a mobile unit which will come to you. After 5:00PM and on weekends, please call the Union County hotline at (908) 214-7107.
