Two Thousand, One Hundred and Forty-Nine (2149) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Eighty-One (2981) In Quarantine.

June 2, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Tuesday, June 2, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at **Two Thousand, One Hundred and Forty-Nine (2149)** within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional **Two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Eighty-One (2981)** individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. There are no new deaths to report today.

Governor Phil Murphy has announced that New Jersey will enter stage two of the restart and recovery plan, "The Road Back: Restoring Economic Health Through Public Health," on June 15, 2020. Stage two will allow outdoor dining at restaurants and openings of non-essential retail. On June 22, barber shops and salons will also be allowed to open. As the state begins to move through the phases of reopening, and as the numbers of infected individuals and deaths get lower each day, I want all Plainfield residents to remember that this crisis is not over. We must still adhere to the safety protocols as advised by our health officials, and we must remember that it is because of these protocols that we've seen a decline in the numbers. We have done our part to keep our Plainfield family safe, but our numbers are still comparatively high, so we must remain vigilant even as the state cautiously moves to reopen.

This Thursday, June 4, at 6:00PM, I will be joined by representatives of the New Jersey Economic Development Authority for a live chat on Facebook. They will share the latest updates on the \$45 million Small Business Emergency Assistance Grant Program
