Two Thousand, One Hundred and Sixty-Six (2166) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Three Thousand, One Hundred and Twelve (3112) In Quarantine.

June 5, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Friday, June 5, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at **Two Thousand, One Hundred and Sixty-Six (2166)** within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional **Three Thousand, One Hundred and Twelve (3112)** individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. There are no new deaths to report today.

On June 4, 2020, Governor Phil Murphy signed an executive order which extends the Public Health Emergency in New Jersey. The declared public health emergency will expire after 30 days unless it is renewed. Let's continue to practice hygiene and social distancing protocols as the state moves towards reopening.
