## From the Mayor's Office

**Two Thousand, Two Hundred and Nineteen (2219) Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield. Additional Three Thousand, Three-Hundred and Forty-One (3341) In Quarantine.**

June 18, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

As of Thursday, June 18, 2020, the number of positive COVID-19 cases in Plainfield now stands at **Two Thousand, Two Hundred and nineteen (2219)** within the ages of twenty-four (24) days old to ninety-six (96) years old. There are an additional **Three Thousand, Three Hundred and Forty-One (3341)** individuals quarantined as a result of exposure to the virus. Of the positive cases, one thousand, four hundred and forty-four (1444) have recovered. Since Tuesday, June 16<sup>th</sup>, there have been two additional deaths reported due to the virus, two African-American males of ages sixty-three (63) and eighty-four (84), bringing the total amount of fatalities to one-hundred and eight (108).

The racial breakdown of COVID-19 cases in Plainfield as of Tuesday, June 16<sup>th</sup>, is as follows:

Hispanic or Latino 1399  
Asian 4  
White 60  
American Indian/Alaskan Native 1  
Other 11  
Unknown 365

Total 2203, Including 1052 Females and 1151 Males

Today, Governor Phil Murphy signed an executive order allowing in-person clinical, lab, and hands-on programming at institutions of higher education beginning on July 1, 2020.
