The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, established by Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, is a federal grant program of the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), which provides funds to communities for neighborhood revitalization and improvement. A consortium of 19 municipalities have joined with the County in allocating monies for housing rehabilitation, public improvements, facility improvements, and social services for more than 40 years, accomplishing many diverse and successful programs and projects.

Residents will be responsible for reviewing approximately thirty (30) CDBG proposals and making funding priorities for City Council approval. Please see meeting schedule below.
