



Dear Colleagues,

We hope you are healthy and safe in these unprecedented times. Iris House remains committed to serving our community and meeting the needs of HIV+ individuals, and as such, would like to introduce and/or remind you of the services we currently have available.

As of June 8, 2020 we will be providing **food assistance** to Ryan White eligible clients in the form of grocery store gift cards. Eligibility requirements include:

1. Documented HIV+ status
2. Income at or below 500% of FPL
3. Residency in Union County (preferred), Essex, Warren, Morris, & Sussex Counties (on a limited basis)

Every effort will be made to provide a contactless delivery, including via mail. However, **transportation assistance**, in the form of bus tickets will be provided for those clients who prefer to come to our office.

Additional services that will continue to be phased in include **Non-medical Case Management** (virtual and in-person) and **Psychosocial Support Groups** (virtual only until further notice).

As a reminder we continue to offer **free HIV testing** (restarting on June 8th) including **at home test kits** (available immediately) as well as **PrEP counseling** and **behavioral interventions** for women living with HIV and those at risk.
